**ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE'S  
LAND USE AND ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 239 TO REGULATE  
THE UTILIZATION OF TEMPORARY STRUCTURES AND  
PORTABLE BUILDINGS INCLUDING PORTABLE SCHOOL  
CLASS ROOMS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE,  
ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION ONE: NON-PERMANENT STRUCTURES:**

That all non-permanent structures such as trailers, sheds, portable school buildings and other such buildings used for business or academic purposes shall be prohibited in all zones with the exception on a temporary basis pending construction of a permanent building. Such structures shall be permitted for a period of three (3) months renewable upon written request from the business owner, up to a maximum of one (1) year. If such structure is under construction, permit shall be issued by the Code Enforcement Officer.

**SECTION TWO: TEMPORARY BUILDINGS:**

Temporary buildings, mobile type trailers, sheds and other such temporary buildings shall be used only in conjunction with construction work with such buildings permitted in any zone and removed immediately upon completion of construction.

**SECTION THREE: REPEALER:**

That the enactment of this zoning ordinance shall in no way affect the requirements and conditions for temporary buildings or structures utilized in a flood zone as defined in City of Bayou La Batre Ordinance No.: 239.
