

**CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE
ORDINANCE NO.: 2003-480**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADJUST SPEED LIMITS
AND TO POST SPEED LIMIT SIGNS**

WHEREAS, the traffic patterns and speeding problems on Shell Belt Road between Faith Street and Adams Street have been studied and certain recommendations have been made to the City Council relative to establishing speed limits in accordance therewith, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bayou La Batre, Alabama has determined that it is in the best interest of the community and for the public health, safety and welfare to adjust the speed limit on Shell Belt Road from Faith Street to Adam Street, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bayou La Batre, Alabama desires to place speed limit signs, which shall reflect the adjusted speed limit on Shell Belt Road from Faith Street to Adams Street, and;

WHEREAS, any violation of the aforementioned posted speed limit shall constitute a traffic offense, pursuant to Alabama Code and within the jurisdiction of the City of Bayou La Batre municipal court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: SPEED LIMITS ON SHELL BELT ROAD

That the speed limit on Shell Belt Road from its intersection with Faith Street north to where it intersects with Adams Street is hereby affixed at 15 m.p.h.

SECTION TWO: PENALTY

Any person who is convicted of speeding in excess of the speed limits as set forth in Section One of this Ordinance shall be fined in accordance with Title 32-5A-8 of the Code of Alabama (1975), as is amended or may be amended, and the City of Bayou La Batre ordinance no:2002-421 as amended.

SECTION THREE: REPEALER

All City ordinances or part thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, and so far as they conflict are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: SEVERABILITY

If any article, section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a declaration of any court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication as required by law.
